Building Collaborative Responses Project Overview

Futures Without Violence provides training and technical assistance to OVW grantees and partner organizations on building collaborations to effectively support survivors of human trafficking with an intersection of domestic violence and sexual assault. **Audience**: multidisciplinary teams, survivor support agencies, and law enforcement.

Training Institute and Webinars

The project offers a 2-day interactive training institute for 3-6 person multidisciplinary teams and may include OVW grantees, attorneys, legal advocates, faith-based providers, law enforcement, or anti-violence advocates. The goals of the institute are to assist participants develop or enhance anti-trafficking collaborations; identify survivorcentered support strategies, and develop action plans to implement a collaborative response to address trafficking in their community.

We also organize national webinars on topics related to advocacy and collaboration. The webinars are open to the public and recorded.

Technical Assistance

FUTURES provides technical assistance to OVW grantees and partners seeking to work collaboratively to support survivors of trafficking. Tailored trainings for organizations and collaboratives may also be available, as resources permit. We also have a toolkit of resources, including sample protocols and case management tools.


