PARTICULARLY WOMEN AND

CHILDREN. WE'LL NOT SEE

DOMESTIC AND SEXUAL

VIOLENCE IN HUMAN

TRAFFICKING HAPPENING IN

ISOLATION FROM EACH OTHER.

RATHER SURVIVORS HAVE MANY

INTERSECTIONS WITH OTHER

LAYERS OF TRAUMAS AND

DIFFERENT EXPERIENCES AND

CIRCUMSTANCES. SO, WE KNOW

HERE SOME OF THE

INTERSECTIONAL AND MICRO

LEVELS OF TRAUMAS PRESENT

IN THE GRAPH. MANY TIMES

PART OF THE SEXUAL

EXPLOITATIONS AND LABOR

EXPLOITATIONS, INCLUDING

POVERTY, LACK OF HOUSING,

LOW ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE.

SO, TRAFFICKING IS ROOTED

IN THERE OF ALL THE

INTERCONNECTS OF THE SYSTEM

OPPRESSION AND MAKING

PEOPLE VULNERABLE FOR

EXPLOITATION AND

TRAFFICKING. KIRICKA WILL

THAT VULNERABILITY TAKING

ADVANTAGE OF VULNERABILITY.

YES, WE SHARED EARLIER.

ALSO, WE SEE DEAF PEOPLE,

THE LACK OF LANGUAGE ACCESS

FOR THE DEAF COMMUNITY.

POVERTY THAT WAS MENTIONED

EARLIER. ISSUES WITH

SELF-IDENTITY AND REACHING

PERSONAL BOUNDARIES, AND

IMMIGRATION STATUS. YES,

THANK YOU FOR SHARING.

THE NEXT SLIDE WE HIGHLIGHT

MANY OF THESE ISSUES THAT

YOU JUST MENTIONED

INCLUDING THE SIMILARITIES

OF PHYSICAL VIOLENCE THEY

EXPERIENCE, POWER AND

CONTROL AND OFTEN SEVERE

PSYCHOLOGICAL TRAUMA. ALSO,

THE CHALLENGES OR FEAR OF

EMBARRASSED OF LEAVING THE

SITUATION AND BRINGING INTO

THEIR COMMUNITY. ALSO,

EXPERIENCES A SIGNIFICANT

ECONOMIC AND IN-FINANCIAL

ABUSE. ALSO, HAVE SIMILAR

COMMUNITY AND TRAFFICKERS

MAY TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THAT

OTHER SERVICES. THAT'S KIND

OF AN OVERVIEW INTRODUCTION

OF THE INTERSECTIONS AND

MORE ABOUT EQUITIES AND IN

EQUITIES THAT SURVIVORS

GOOD MORNING AND AFTERNOON,

DEPENDING ON WHERE EVERYONE

IS. IT IS A PERFECT SEGWAY

LOOKING INTO INEQUITIES. A

LOT OF SURVIVORS REFER TO

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND

SEXUAL ASSAULT

ORGANIZATIONS, DUE TO THE

FACT THAT YOU ARE OUT IN

THE COMMUNITY AND YOU ARE

DOING THE WORK. IT MAY NOT

BE SPECIFIC TO HUMAN

TRAFFICKING BUT YOU ARE THE

FACE THAT PEOPLE SEE IN

LOCAL COMMUNITIES. YOU ARE

DOING OUTREACH AND WORKING

SPECIFICALLY WITH ALL TYPES

OF SURVIVORS BUT ALSO

HELPING THEM WITH

RESOURCES. SO, A LOT OF

TIMES YOU ARE GOING TO BE

THE INITIAL CONTACT BECAUSE

PEOPLE MAY NOT EVEN HAVE

OTHER AGENCIES IN THEIR

LOCAL COMMUNITY THAT THEY

KNOW OR TRUST. AND SO WHEN

WE ARE THINKING ABOUT

EQUITY, I ALWAYS LOVE THIS

IMAGE AND I AM SURE MOST OF

YOU HAVE SEEN THIS IMAGE

BUT LOOKING AT THE

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN EQUITY

AND INEQUALITY IS. FOR A

LONG TIME, WE TALK A LOT

ABOUT MAKING SURE THAT THE

SERVICES WE DELIVER TO

SURVIVORS ARE EQUAL. WE

HAVE LEARNED OVER THE

COURSE OF TIME THAT

EQUALITY AND EQUITY ARE SO

DIFFERENT. JUST BECAUSE IT

IS EQUALLED, DOES NOT MAKE

IT FAIR AND DOES NOT MAKE

IT EASIER FOR SOMEONE TO

ACCESS YOUR SERVICES. WHEN

WE ARE LOOKING AT INEQUITY,

WE ARE LOOKING AT BARRIERS.

WE ARE THINKING ABOUT WHAT

ARE SOME OF THOSE THINGS

THAT MAKING US VULNERABLE

OR SUSCEPTIBLE TO

TRAFFICKING AND DURING

TRAFFICKING, WE ARE

THINKING ABOUT WHAT DOES IT

LOOK LIKE WHEN WE ARE

THINKING OF STEREOTYPES AND

PERCEPTIONS THAT PEOPLE

HAVE IN SOCIETY ABOUT

TRAFFICKERS AND WHAT

PERPETRATORS MAY LOOK LIKE

AND WHO THEY MAY BE. AND

ALSO THINKING ABOUT WHEN

PEOPLE ARE ACCESSING

SERVICES. OH, I HAVE NOT

SEEN THAT. I WAS READING

LINDA'S COMMENT ABOUT THE

ONE WHERE THE FENCE IS

MOVED AND IT IS CALLED

COLORATION, I LOVE THAT. I

AM LOOKING FORWARD TO SEE

THAT ONE. ALSO, ONE OF THE

THINGS WE'LL TALK ABOUT

TODAY IS LOOKING AT SOME OF

THOSE SERVICE PROVIDER

BIASES. WHAT IS THAT

EXPERIENCE THAT A SURVIVOR

IS DEALING WITH EVEN AFTER

THE TRAFFICKING AND LOOKING

AT AFTER CARES

SPECIFICALLY. NEXT SLIDE?

IF WE ARE TALKING ABOUT

INEQUALITY AND EQUITY AND

WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE. ONE OF

THE THINGS WE WANT TO MAKE

SURE IS WE ARE FULLY USING

THE DEFINITION IN WHICH WE

CHOOSE TO DO THIS WORK

WHICH IS REALLY TO THINK

ABOUT IN ORDER TO BE REALLY

EFFECTIVE. WE HAVE TO

FIGURE OUT A COMPREHENSIVE

APPROACH TO REALLY PROTECT

AND MOSTLY TO PREVENT

RACIAL INJUSTICE AND MAKING

SURE THAT WE ARE MAKING

SURE THINGS ARE E QUITABLE

ACROSS POLICIES AND

PROGRAMS. THIS DEPARTMENT

IS REALLY LOOKING AT HOW

SURVIVORS AND OTHER EXPERTS

HAVE FOUND THAT A LOT OF

TIMES IN-GRAINED, RACIAL,

GENDER, BIASES AND

STEREOTYPES, CREATED IN A

WAY TO DEHUMANIZE A LOT OF

COMMUNITIES. THAT CAUSES US

TO THEN ALMOST SEE WHERE

PEOPLE ARE JUSTIFYING, THE

EXPLOITATION AND EXCLUSION

OF CERTAIN CULTURES AND

CERTAIN GROUPS, RIGHT?

THAT'S WHAT WE REALLY WANT

TO MAKE SURE THAT WE HAVE

AN EQUITY LENS WHEN WE ARE

TALKING ABOUT THIS ISSUE,

AND ENSURING THAT PEOPLE

HAVE EQUAL AND EQUITABLE

ACCESS. ONE OF THE THINGS I

ALWAYS TALK ABOUT WHEN WE

ARE DOING TRAINING

SPECIFICALLY WITH LAW

ENFORCEMENT AND COURT

ADVOCATES. PEOPLE WHO ARE

NOT ON THAT ADVOCACY SIDE

OF WORK IS THAT YOU

TYPICALLY ARE GOING TO FIND

WHAT YOU ARE LOOKING FOR.

SO, IF YOU HAVE A

STEREOTYPE OF MOST

TRAFFICKERS BEING BLACK AND

BROWN, YOU ARE GOING TO

FIND MORE BLACK AND BROWN

TRAFFICKERS, RIGHT? AND IF

YOU HAVE A CERTAIN

STEREOTYPE OF WHAT AN

ACTUAL TRAFFICKING SURVIVOR

MAY LOOK LIKE, THAT'S WHO

YOU ARE GOING TO FIND. SO,

WHAT HAPPENS THEN IS WE

MISS SO MANY SURVIVORS AND

SO MANY PERPETRATORS

BECAUSE WE ARE LOOKING FOR

THIS SPECIFIC MODEL OR

IMAGE THAT WE HAVE SEEN IN

THE MEDIA. I SEE JULIA JUST

MENTIONED AS A LEGAL

ADVOCATE, MANY SURVIVORS

DON'T WANT MUCH TO DO WITH

LAW ENFORCEMENT. E WE SEE

THIS AS SOMETHING THAT'S

SUPER COMMON. IT IS A LOT

OF PIECES, AND WE'LL TALK

MORE ABOUT LAW ENFORCEMENT

INVOLVEMENT WITH SURVIVORS

AND YOU KNOW WE HAVE HAD SO

MANY SURVIVORS WHO ARE

FEARFUL OF LAW ENFORCEMENT

AND NOT ALWAYS BECAUSE OF

THEIR TRAFFICKING

SITUATIONS, BUT IT MAY BE

BECAUSE THEY ARE FROM

ANOTHER COUNTRY AND THE WAY

LAW ENFORCEMENT WORK THERE.

IF YOU ARE IN A

NEIGHBORHOOD, FRANCIS IS A

PERSON OF COLOR, LAW

ENFORCEMENT IN OUR

COMMUNITIES LOOK DIFFERENT,

SO, FIGURING OUT A LOT OF

TIMES HOW DO WE WORK WITH

OUR LAW ENFORCEMENT TO

ENSURE THAT WE HAVE A

DIVERSITY AND SORT OF

EQUITY IN INCLUSION LENS

WHEN WE ARE DOING THIS WORK

IS GOING TO BE CRITICAL TO

EVEN YOUR WORK IN ADVOCACY.

THANKS FOR PUTTING THAT UP,

JULIA. NEXT SLIDE? SO, I

WILL MENTION THIS BRIEFLY

BUT I WILL HIGHLIGHT THIS

IN PARTICULAR AS WE THINK

OF SOME OF THOSE INEQUITIES

BEFORE TRAFFICKING OCCURS.

WE ARE LOOKING AT WHAT ARE

SOME OF THOSE THINGS THAT

REALLY CAUSE PEOPLE TO

HAVE, YOU KNOW, TO BE MORE

SUSCEPTIBLE TO HUMAN

TRAFFICKING. WE THINK OF

POVERTY. IF YOU ARE LACKING

BASIC RESOURCES, A LOT OF

TIMES THERE ARE A LOT OF

THINGS THAT YOU MAY BE

WILLING TO DO OR FEEL LIKE

YOU HAVE TO DO BECAUSE YOU

DON'T HAVE THOSE BASIC

RESOURCES OR YOU ARE IN A

SITUATION WHERE YOU JUST

NEED FOOD OR YOU NEED

CLOTHING OR SHELTER. SO,

PEOPLE EXPLOIT THAT, RIGHT?

ALSO THINKING OF THE HIGH

RATES OF DISCRIMINATION. WE

SEE IT SO MUCH WHEN PEOPLE

ARE BEING DISCRIMINATED

AGAINST. ONE OF THE FIRST

THINGS I KNOW SO MANY

CLIENTS THAT I HAVE TALKED

TO OVER THE YEARS SAID IS

"WHO'S GOING TO BELIEVE

ME?"

IT IS THEIR WORDS AND NOT

MINE. AND I KNOW AND IT IS

SUCH A THING. ALSO, AS WE

ARE TALKING ABOUT IT IN AN

ADVOCACY LENS, ALTHOUGH I

AM GOING TO HIGHLIGHT IT

LATER. I WANT TO POINT OUT

THAT WE WANT TO THINK ABOUT

THE FACT THAT SOME VICTIMS

ACTUALLY REALLY DO WANT TO

WORK WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT.

IT IS NOT JUST A LAW

ENFORCEMENT THING. IT IS A

SYSTEM BARRIER ISSUE SO

THAT COULD BE IN OUR

ADVOCACY WORK, IT COULD BE

IN LAW ENFORCEMENT CRIMINAL

JUSTICE SYSTEM. IT IS

REALLY ABOUT HOW DO WE

REMOVE SOME OF THOSE

BARRIERS AND INEQUITIES.

THAT'S SO IMPORTANT NOT

JUST TO PLACE IT ON LAW

ENFORCEMENT BECAUSE WE

SPEND A LOT OF TIME TALKING

ABOUT HOW THEY'RE NOT DOING

OR HAVING ISSUES BUT WE AS

ADVOCATES ALSO HAVE TO DO

THE INTERNAL WORK. SO, ALSO

THINK ABOUT INCREASE

EXPERIENCES OF VIOLENCE AND

TRAUMAS. NOT ONLY THINGS

THAT'S HAPPENING CURRENTLY

BECAUSE WE HAVE SEEN SOME

OF THE ISSUES THAT ARE IN

THE NEWS AND IN THE MEDIA

THAT ARE HAPPENING

CURRENTLY THAT IMPACTS THE

WAY PEOPLE ARE FEELING AND

HOW THEY ARE BEING TREATED.

WE HAVE TO THINK ABOUT

TRAUMA IN A HISTORICAL

CONTEXT AND WHAT'S

HAPPENING TO BRING US TO

THIS POINT? I SEE ELEANOR

MENTIONING THE GREATER

NEEDS HIGHER THAN THE

RISKS. ABSOLUTELY. THAT'S

WHY WHEN WE ARE SPENDING A

LOT OF TIME TALKING ABOUT

MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES

AND WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE FOR

CERTAIN GROUPS, WE HAVE TO

THINK ABOUT THAT. I USUALLY

IS A PERSON WHO I SEE A LOT

OF PEOPLE TALK ABOUT ACES,

THE ADVERSE CHILDHOOD

EXPERIENCES. A LOT OF TIME

WE SPEND A LOT OF TIME

TALKING ABOUT ACES AND HOW

PEOPLE ARE MORE VULNERABLE

IF THEY HAVE A HIGHER LEVEL

OF ACES. I AM A PERSON WHO

REALLY SAYS THAT. THAT'S

GREAT, WE WANT TO KNOW THAT

PEOPLE HAVE BEEN EXPOSED A

LITTLE BIT MORE TO CERTAIN

EXPERIENCES THAT MAY PUT

THEM AT HIGHER RISK.

HOWEVER, WE WANT TO BE

CAREFUL THAT WE ARE NOT

TAKING PEOPLE'S SITUATIONS

AND CIRCUMSTANCES OF THEIR

RACE OR SOCIO-ECONOMIC

STATUS OR LITERACY AND

MAKING THEM FEEL BAD ABOUT

THAT. SAYING YOU ARE MORE

EXPOSED TO VIOLENCE BECAUSE

YOU DON'T HAVE OR YOU ARE

OF THIS SPECIFIC GROUP. IT

IS IMPORTANT TO THINK ABOUT

HOW WE ARE REFRAMED O THE

WAY WE TALK ABOUT THIS

ISSUE AND NOT MAKING PEOPLE

FEEL BAD ABOUT WHO THEY ARE

AND WHERE THEY COME FROM. I

SEE JENNIFER MENTIONING SO

MANY DISPARITIES IN THE

CRIMINAL COURT SYSTEM.

ABSOLUTELY. I THINK THIS

VIDEO, WE ARE GOING TO SHOW

A SURVIVOR TALKING ABOUT

WENT TO A FOSTER HOME. THEY

WENT TO LIVE WITH A

BOYFRIEND OR WENT TO DO

THAT OR YOU KNEW HOW TO

SURVIVE. CHILDREN THAT'S IN

THE FOSTER CARE SYSTEM, WE

DON'T KNOW WHERE WE ARE

SUPPOSED TO BE. IT IS LIKE

LITERALLY, YOU DON'T KNOW

WHERE YOU ARE SUPPOSED TO

BE. OKAY, I WAS HERE LAST

BUT WHEN I WENT BACK THERE,

SHE TOLD ME SHE DON'T HAVE

ROOM ANYMORE. IT IS LIKE,

DO I GO TO THE SOCIAL WORK?

IF YOU WENT AWAY FROM YOUR

FOSTER HOME OR WENT AWAY

FROM ANYTHING, YOU ARE

CONSIDERED A RUN AWAY

YOUTH, WHICH YOU CAN GET

ARRESTED FOR.

CASE IT BELONG TO?

HAD SOMEONE TO GROW YOUR

SELF-ESTEEM.

OF THINGS TO THINK ABOUT.

ONE OF THE THINGS TO THINK

ABOUT AND IF YOU DON'T MIND

TYPE IN THE CHAT ABOUT SOME

THOUGHTS ABOUT THIS. WE ARE

THINKING ABOUT HOW WE WANT

TO ENSURE THAT WE ARE

MEANINGFULLY INVOLVING

SURVIVORS ALONG THE WAY

WHEN WE ARE DOING THIS

WORK. WE WANT TO MAKE SURE

AND I THINK ASHLEY'S STORY

IS SO IMPORTANT TO KIND OF

HIGHLIGHT THIS. WE WANT TO

MAKE SURE THAT WE ARE NOT

JUST INVOLVING THEM IN

THEIR CASE BUT WE ARE ALSO

INVOLVING THEM WHEN WE ARE

THINKING ABOUT DEVELOPING

PROGRAMMING, WE WANT TO

THINK ABOUT THAT WHEN WE

ARE PLANNING A LOT OF THE

EVENTS AND OUTREACH AND

THINGS THAT WE ARE DOING.

REALLY ASKING THEM WHAT

THEIR OPINIONS ARE AND WHAT

THEIR EXPERIENCES ARE AND

NOT THEIR EXPERIENCES BEING

TRAFFICKED BUT WHAT ARE

THEIR EXPERIENCES WITH THE

SYSTEM OF THE WORK WE ARE

DOING WITH THEM, RIGHT?

BECAUSE WHO KNOWS BETTER

THAN A SURVIVOR OF WHAT

THEY HAVE EXPERIENCED AND

WHAT WORKS AND WHAT DOES

NOT WORK? I THINK IT IS

IMPORTANT TO HEAR WHAT

ASHLEY SAID BECAUSE

NUMEROUS TIMES SHE TRIED TO

TELL PEOPLE, BUT BECAUSE

THERE WAS THIS LABEL SORT

OF ALREADY PLACED ON HER

FOR SO MANY REASONS, PEOPLE

DIDN'T AUTOMATICALLY

BELIEVE HER. AND SO IT IS

IMPORTANT TO THINK ABOUT

HOW DO WE ENSURE THAT

SURVIVORS VOICES ARE BEING

HEARD AS WE DO THIS WORK.

NEXT SLIDE. REALLY THE

PURPOSE OF THIS ONE IS

REALLY TO KIND OF, WE WANT

YOU TO LOOK AT THIS VIDEO

BUT TO ALSO THINK ABOUT

ASHLEY AND HER STORY, THINK

ABOUT WHAT ARE SOME OF

THOSE INEQUITIES THAT SHE

WAS EXPERIENCING WHILE

BEING TRAFFICKED. SO, I AM

GOING TO KIND OF GO THROUGH

THIS SLIDE. PLEASE FEEL

FREE TO TYPE IN THE CHAT OF

WHAT ARE SOME OF THE THINGS

YOU NOTICE WHERE INEQUITIES

WERE BARRIERS THAT ASHLEY

FACED AS SHE WAS GOING

THROUGH HER TRAFFICKING

SITUATION. I SEE LORAIN

MENTIONED ABOUT CONSISTENCY

IS VERY IMPORTANT. THAT'S

ONE OF THE BIGGEST THINGS

IS THINKING ABOUT

CONSISTENCY AND NOT MAKING

PROMISES THAT YOU CAN'T

KEEP BECAUSE THAT'S

SOMETHING THAT SURVIVORS

HAVE EXPERIENCED THE WHOLE

TIME, RIGHT? I HAVE SEEN

SOME INFORMATION OF ACCESS

TO SERVICES AND BEING IN

FOSTER CARE AND RACE. SHE

WAS EASILY BEING DISMISSED

AND SWITCHED FROM SOCIAL

WORKER TO SOCIAL WORKER.

REALLY LOOKING AT HOW NOT

BEING THE LEAD BECAUSE OF

HER AGE. PEOPLE NOT TALK TO

HER AND NOT COMMUNICATING

WITH HER, BEING BELIEVED

AND SEEN BELIEVED -- HOW

SHE'S BEING LABELED. I

THINK ONE THING I KEEP

SEEING A LOT OF PIECES COME

UP ABOUT PEOPLE REALLY

BLAMING HER AND NOT

BELIEVING HER, AND BEING

LABELED IN NOT TALKING TO

HER ABOUT WHAT WAS

HAPPENING WITH HER. I THINK

IT IS HUGE BECAUSE I

REMEMBER A COUPLE OF

SURVIVORS THAT WE HAVE

WORKED WITH OVER THE YEARS

BUT ALSO DID I KNOW

PERSONALLY HAVE TALKED

ABOUT HOW OFTENTIMES MONEY

WAS BEING EXCHANGED FOR

THEM WHEN THEY WERE IN

FOSTER CARE, CHILD WELFARE

AND NO ONE WAS TALKING TO

THEM.

THEY WERE JUST BEING TOLD

THEY HAD TO GO TO THIS NEW

FOSTER HOME. SOMEONE WAS

GIVING MONEY FOR THEM TO

COME THERE. EVENTUALLY,

THEY WERE SWITCHED TO

ANOTHER FOSTER HOME OR

ANOTHER FAMILY AND THEY

WERE BEING GIVEN MONEY FOR

THEM TO GO THERE.

WHEN THE TRAFFICKER ASKS

THEM TO DO THE SAME THING,

WHY DID IT FEEL ANY

DIFFERENCE FOR THEM. WE

CREATE THIS SYSTEM AND IT

MAKES IT REALLY WHERE WE

ARE TRYING TO AND WE FEEL

LIKE WE ARE DOING RIGHT BY

THE SURVIVORS BUT IN

ACTUALLY WE ARE DOING MORE

HARM BECAUSE WE ARE NOT

TAKING TIME TO COMMUNICATE

AND TALK TO THEM AND

EXPLAIN TO THEM WHAT'S

HAPPENING. AS YOU CAN SEE

ASHLEY TRULY UNDERSTOOD

WHAT WAS HAPPENING TO HER

BUT NO ONE WAS LISTENING. I

SEE A LOT ABOUT NOT BEING

HEARD. PEOPLE TALKING AT

THEM AND NOT TO THEM.

THAT'S THE BIGGEST THING.

ONE OF THE THINGS IS

LIMITED RESOURCES WHEN WE

ARE THINKING OF CULTURE AND

LINGUISTIC INAPPROPRIATE.

WHETHER WHEN I AM DOING A

SITE VISIT OR COMING IN FOR

CONSULTATIONS ABOUT VARIOUS

THINGS, ONE OF THE THINGS

THAT I WILL LOOK AT IS WHAT

HAIR CARE PRODUCT DO YOU

HAVE.

WHEN YOU ARE THINKING OF

PERSONAL CARE AND YOU ARE

REALLY WORKING WITH

SURVIVORS AND YOU HAVE A

RARE DIVERSE GROUP OF

SURVIVORS WHO COME INTO

YOUR SHELTER, ARE YOU

THINKING OF THE DIFFERENT

HAIR TYPES OR THE DIFFERENT

TYPES OF FOOD PEOPLE EAT.

THEY SHOULD NOT BE EXPECTED

TO FALL IN LINE WITH

WHATEVER YOU ARE DOING OR

USE WHATEVER YOU HAVE IT.

THEY ARE AVAILABLE BECAUSE

THAT'S WHAT THEY WERE DOING

IN THE TRAFFICKING

SITUATION. IT IS IMPORTANT

TO THINK ABOUT THAT AND

ASHLEY TALKS ABOUT THE

SECOND BULLET AND EVERYONE

HIGHLIGHTED THAT, WHICH IS

FEAR OF NOT BEING BELIEVED

AND WHEN THAT'S BEING

PROVEN THROUGH, THAT'S WHAT

HAPPENED. SOMEONE MENTIONED

ABOUT BEING GROOMED. WHEN

YOU FEEL LIKE NO ONE IS

BELIEVING YOU THEN YOU ARE

BEING DISMISSED EASILY. WHY

DO I BOTHER TO HAVE THIS

CONVERSATION BECAUSE NO ONE

ELSE IS GOING TO BELIEVE ME

AS WELL.

ABSOLUTELY. THINK ABOUT

INCREASING EXPERIENCE FOR

CRIMINALIZATION ACTIVITIES

THAT OCCURRED AS A RESULT

OF TRAFFICKING.

IF WE HAVE SEEN SO MANY

TIMES THEY HAVE BEEN

ARRESTED FOR SHOPLIFTING OR

PANHANDLING AND WE THINK OF

PROSTITUTION AS A CHARGE.

WE DON'T THINK OF SOME OF

THOSE THINGS AND LOOKING AT

HOW THOSE CRIMINALIZATION

ARE SIMPLY -- I NEEDED FOOD

TO EAT BECAUSE MY

TRAFFICKER WAS NOT FEEDING

ME. IT IS HARDER TO WORK

WITH OR PEOPLE TO GET

ESPUNGED. I AM THINKING OF

RAMADAN AND SURVIVORS AND

FOOD AT DIFFERENT TIMES AND

THINKING ABOUT REMEMBER

VICTIMS ARE HUMANS FIRST

AND GIVING THEM THE ABILITY

TO RECLAIMING THEIR CHOICES

AND ABILITY. WE CAN'T TAKE

CHOICES FROM SURVIVORS AND

EXPECT THEM TO WORK WITH US

WHEN THAT'S WHAT'S BEEN

DONE TO GET THEM IN THE

TRAFFICKING SITUATION,

ABSOLUTELY.

THE LACK OF UNDERSTANDING

IN THE SYSTEM AND FEAR THAT

THEIR OWN SYSTEM WOULD PUT

THE PERSON WHEN THEY WANT

TO SPEAK FOR THEMSELVES AND

NOT FEEL LIKE THEY CAN

REALLY TAKE ACCOUNTABILITY

FOR WHAT THOSE SYSTEMS LAG.

I AM SEEING A LOT OF REALLY

GOOD COMMENTS, PLEASE KEEP

IT COMING. I SEE BEING

CRIMINALIZED AND FORCED TO

BE ON THE SRO EVEN AS A

MINOR. I THINK THIS IS A

HUGE ONE AS WELL. BECAUSE

WHILE WE ARE TALKING ABOUT

MAKING SURE -- WE WANT TO

ALSO THINK ABOUT IF YOU

DON'T HAVE ANYONE ON STAFF

WHO REPRESENTS OR I FEEL

LIKE REPRESENTS ME, LOOKS

LIKE ME, SPEAKS THE SAME

LANGUAGE AS ME, ANY OF

THOSE THINGS, THEN WHY

WOULD I FEEL LIKE YOU WOULD

BE ABLE TO WORK WITH ME OR

UNDERSTAND WHERE I AM. I

SEE SOMEONE ASKING A

QUESTION RELATED TO

TRAFFICKING. A LOT OF

PEOPLE DON'T KNOW WHAT

THOSE QUESTIONS ARE THAT

THEY SHOULD BE ASKING. WE

CAN GO TO THE NEXT SLIDE. I

THINK THAT'S A REALLY BIG

THING. EVEN AS A PROVIDER,

IF YOU KNOW THAT YOU HAVE A

SURVIVOR IN FRONT OF YOU

AND YOU ARE OFFERING THEM

THINGS, YOU WANT TO MAKE

SURE YOU DON'T SAY WHAT

WOULD YOU LIKE TO DRINK. IF

YOU ONLY HAD WATER,

MOUNTAIN DEW OR SWEET TEA

OR WHATEVER. IF I SAY I

WANT A SPRITE AND YOU DON'T

HAVE THAT. I WANT COFFEE

AND YOU DON'T HAVE THAT. IT

IS ANOTHER WAY. IT SEEMS

SIMPLE BUT YOU ARE

DISAPPOINTING THAT

SURVIVOR, RIGHT? IT MAKES

IT HARD FOR ME BECAUSE I

FEEL LIKE YOU ARE

DISAPPOINTING ME AND

LETTING ME DOWN. I KNOW

ANOTHER THING. I THINK

THAT'S A BIG THING TO THINK

ABOUT WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE. I

KNOW A LOT OF TIMES IT IS

REALLY THE ATTITUDE OR

STEREOTYPE THAT WE HAVE

THAT AFFECTS OUR

UNDERSTANDING AND ACTIONS.

SOMETIMES OF THE DECISIONS

WE MAKE IT IN AND A LOT OF

TIMES IT IS UNCONSCIOUS AND

REALLY THINKING ABOUT THERE

ARE SOME REALLY

INTERNALIZED MESSAGING THAT

SOCIETY IS GIVING US. IT IS

NOT OFTEN OUR INTENT BUT IT

CAN HARM SURVIVORS AND THE

PEOPLE WE ARE WORKING WITH.

IT IS THINKING ABOUT HOW WE

ARE EVALUATING OR WHATEVER

OUR BELIEFS ARE WHETHER

THEY ARE POSITIVE OR

NEGATIVE.

AND UNDERSTAND WHAT YOUR

BIASES ARE. IT IS ABOUT

KNOWING WHAT THEY ARE AND

ACKNOWLEDGING THEM AND

FIGURING OUT HOW TO MOVE

PASS THEM OR IF THERE ARE

CERTAIN THINGS THAT YOU

CAN'T DO OR THAT YOU ARE

NOT EQUIPPED TO WORKING

WITH CERTAIN SITUATIONS

THEN YOU FIGURE OUT WHO

THAT CAN SUPPORT YOU THERE.

THERE IS NO SHAME IN

RECOGNIZING WHEN YOU HAVE

TRIGGERS OR YOU HAVE

SOMETHING THAT WAS

TRAUMATIC IN YOUR PAST THAT

KEEPS YOU FROM REALLY BEING

ABLE TO FULLY INVEST THAT

SITUATION THAT'S IN FRONT

OF YOU. IT IS SOMETHING

THAT IN HARMING A PERSON

WHEN YOU KNOW THESE THINGS

AND YOU JUST DON'T WANT TO

KIND OF LET GO BECAUSE YOU

FEEL LIKE YOU ARE THE

PERSON THAT'S IN CONTROL.

THINKING ABOUT THAT IN

PARTICULAR. SO, REALLY

THINKING OF THOSE MOMENTS

OF HIGH-STRESS AND

SUBJECTIVITY. I KNOW MINORS

ARE PUT TO THE SIDE BECAUSE

ADULTS BELIEVE THAT

CHILDREN WOULD LIE TO GET

THEIR WAY. WE SEE THAT

OFTEN, RIGHT? A LOT OF

ADULTS DON'T BELIEVE

MINORS, RIGHT? IT IS LIKE

BECAUSE YOU ARE A CHILD.

THERE IS OTHER PHRASE THAT

IT STAYS IN A CHILD'S

PLACE. THEY DON'T KNOW

WHAT'S BEST FOR THEM. THESE

CHILDREN WHO HAVE BEEN

TRAFFICKED OFTENTIMES HAVE

BEEN IN SITUATIONS THAT

ADULTS WOULD NOT BE OKAY TO

BE IN. NOW, WE WANT THEM

TO -- NEXT SLIDE. SO, I WAS

THINKING OF IMPLICIT BIAS,

WHAT ARE THE BIGGEST THINGS

IS REALLY THINKING ABOUT

HOW DO WE ADDRESS IT? JUST

MAKING SURE WHEN YOU ARE

WORKING WITH OTHER

PROFESSIONALS THAT YOU

REALLY ARE FIGURING OUT

WHAT YOUR ROLES ARE AND I

THINK ONE OF THE BIGGEST

WAYS TO ADDRESS IMPLICIT

BIAS IS TO FIGURE OUT WHAT

YOUR ROLE IS AND WHAT YOUR

AGENCY'S ROLE IS. WHILE YOU

ARE AT THE TABLE AND

ESPECIALLY IN

COLLABORATION, HOW DO YOU

WORK WITH EACH OTHER?

KNOWING SOMETHING AS SIMPLE

AS - I AM IN NORTH

CAROLINA, I SEE QUITE A FEW

PEOPLE FROM NORTH CAROLINA

IN THE WEBINAR. ONE OF THE

THINGS THAT I NOTICES IS

WORKING WITH OUR CHILD

ADVOCACY CENTER. SEVERAL

YEARS BACK, WE DID A

PROJECT WITH THEM, ONE

THING THAT WE DIDN'T

REALIZE IS THAT SEVERAL OF

THE TRIAL ADVOCACY CENTERS

DO NOT NECESSARILY HAVE A

24/7 ADVOCATE ON-SITE AND

RESPONDING. A LOT OF THE

TIMES, WE HAD LAW

ENFORCEMENT OR OTHER TEAM

MEMBERS WHO ASSUMED THAT

THEY HAD A 24/7 RESPONSE

AND THEY WOULD SEND

REFERRALS AND TAKE CALLS.

SO HAVING EVERYONE TO GET

IN THE ROOM AND HAVING A

DISCUSSION OF WHAT'S YOUR

RESPONSE PROTOCOL. ARE YOU

A 24/7 RESPONDING? NO, WE

CLOSE AT 5:00. SOMETHING AS

SIMPLE OF HAVING THOSE

DISCUSSIONS SO WE

UNDERSTAND WHAT OUR ROLES

ARE AND WHAT OUR

CAPABILITIES ARE BUT ALSO

UNDERSTANDING OF WHAT SOME

OF THE THINGS PEOPLE THINK

MAY BE TRUE BUT ARE NOT AND

VICE VERSA AND WORKING

TOWARDS COMMON GOALS AND

WORKING RELATIONSHIPS. A

LOT OF TIMES AT LEAST FOR

ME, I REMEMBER A PERSON WHO

WAS OVER OUR FATE,

COALITION FOR HUMAN

TRAFFICKING FOR SEVERAL

YEARS, THERE WAS ALWAYS

TENSIONS BETWEEN CERTAIN

AGENCIES AND THAT WAS

BECAUSE AT SOME POINT, SOME

PERSON WHO WORK FOR ONE

AGENCY AND ANOTHER PERSON

WORKING FOR ANOTHER AGENCY

HAD AN ISSUE. EITHER A CASE

DIDN'T GO WELL OR SOMETHING

DIDN'T HAPPEN THE WAY IT

WAS SUPPOSED TO. THERE WAS

A DISAGREEMENT. THESE

AGENCIES DON'T GET ALONG

AND THEY DON'T WORK WELL

TOGETHER, RIGHT? WE JUST

HAVE NOT HAD THAT

CONVERSATION TO FIGURE OUT

WHAT WENT WRONG AND THOSE

TWO PEOPLE ARE NOT AT THESE

AGENCIES ANYMORE AT THIS

POINT. WE ARE STILL HOLDING

THAT BIAS AGAINST THAT

AGENCY BECAUSE OF SOMETHING

THAT HAPPENED AND WE WERE

NOT PREVIEWED TO IT AND IT

MAY NOT BE THE VERSION WE

HAVE IN OUR HEAD WHEN THE

STORY THAT'S TOLD THREE OR

FOUR OR FIVE DIFFERENT

TIMES IS NOT REALLY

HAPPENING, RIGHT? I SAY IT

TO SAY THAT IT IS IMPORTANT

TO BE PROFESSIONAL AND TO

MONITOR YOUR ATTITUDE AND

HAVE THOSE CONVERSATIONS

WITH OTHER PROVIDERS. WHEN

YOU ARE WORKING WITH OTHER

PEOPLE AND THEY'RE AT THE

TABLE, YOU ALL ARE

COLLABORATING TO SUPPORT

SURVIVORS, I CAN TELL YOU

THAT IF THEY CAN FEEL THE

TENSION, THE SURVIVOR CAN

FEEL IT AS WELL. MAKING

SURE THEY ARE COMFORTABLE.

ALSO, THINKING ABOUT AS

DEVIANT AGENCIES AND THE

NUMBER OF TIMES PEOPLE SAY,

WE ARE NOT EQUIPPED TO

SERVE TRAFFICKING VICTIMS.

IF YOU ARE NOT, WHO IS? YOU

ARE THE ONES THAT ARE

TRAINED IN TRAUMAS AND IN

CASE MANAGEMENT, IN

ADVOCACIES AND ALL OF THE

THINGS THAT REALLY, YOU

KNOW, SURVIVORS NEED IN

THOSE NEXT STEPS, YOU ARE

TRAINED IN THEM. I HAVE

HEARD AGENCY SAYING I AM

CONCERNED OF A TRAFFICKING

SURVIVOR BEING IN MY

SHELTER BECAUSE WHAT IF

THEY CALL THEIR TRAFFICKER?

I THINK MY RESPONSE TO THAT

IS HAVE YOU EVER HAD A

SURVIVOR WHO WAS CALLED

THEIR PERPETRATOR? IT FEELS

SOMEONE POSTED NETWORKING

IS SO IMPORTANT SO CLIENTS

DON'T FALL THROUGH THE

CRACK. ABSOLUTELY, FOLLOW

UP ON THE SITUATION AND

RESOURCES WITH ALL

PROVIDERS. FOLLOW-UP IS

FIRST, SECOND, THIRD. YOU

CAN ASSUME THAT THE WORK

MAY BE DONE AND IT MAY NOT

BE. SOMETIMES NOT EVERYONE

INTENTIONAL. SOMEONE ELSE

THINKS THAT SOMEONE ELSE

HAD DONE IT, RIGHT? NEXT

SLIDE? ONE OF THE THINGS WE

WANT TO HIGHLIGHT IS WE ARE

LOOKING AT EQUITY AND

LOOKING AT INCLUSION. WE

WANT TO THINK ABOUT WHAT

ARE SOME OF THOSE THINGS

IN SERVICE DELIVERY THAT

KEEPS SURVIVORS FROM FEEL

SO, YOU WANT TO THINK ABOUT

THE NUMBER ONE THING THAT

WE SEE IS DYSFUNCTIONAL

RESCUING AND REALLY

THINKING ABOUT BASING

THINGS OFF OF ASSUMPTIONS

THAT SURVIVORS CAN'T HELP

THEMSELVES. WE CALL THAT

THE HELP THAT DOES NOT

ACTUALLY HELP, RIGHT?

PEOPLE DON'T NEED TO BE

RESCUED. THEY NEED

EMPOWERMENT AND RESOURCES,

SUPPORT. THEY DON'T NEED

YOU TO SAVE THEM. TO ME,

WHEN YOU ARE THINKING OF

RESCUING, YOU ARE REALLY

FOCUSED MORE ON HOW IT

MAKES YOU FEEL AS A PERSON.

WE ARE PATERNALISTIC

SOCIETY, RIGHT? WE ARE

ALWAYS HELPING AND HELP

THOSE WHO NEED AND WHY

HELPING IS GREAT, YOU DON'T

WANT US TO MOVE INTO TOO

MUCH OF THE RESCUING

MENTALITY. ANOTHER ONE FROM

THIS LIST IS REALLY BEING

CAREFUL NOT TO DENY

DIFFERENCES. HOW MANY TIMES

HAVE YOU HEARD SOMEONE SAY

OH, I DON'T SEE COLOR. BUT,

YOU NEED TO SEE IT AND YOU

NEED TO ACCEPT THAT PEOPLE

ARE DIFFERENT AND WE ARE

GOING TO HAVE DIFFERENCES

WHETHER IT IS BECAUSE OF

OUR -- ANY OF OUR

IDENTITIES. IT DOES CAUSE A

ALL MET, THE PRINCIPAL

SAID, WELL, I SAW IT BUT

THAT'S SOMETHING THAT THE

CULTURE DOES. THAT ONE

STEREOTYPE THAT THIS

DIFFERENCES, WE HAVE TO

STOP THE CULTURE THAT LAW

ENFORCEMENT HAVE. LEGAL

SERVICES, WE ALL HAVE A

CULTURE. WE NEED TO THINK

ABOUT HOW DOES THAT SHOW UP

AND HOW DOES THAT PLAY OUT

WHEN WE ARE THINKING ABOUT

CONFIDENTIALITY AND

PRIVILEGE, ALL OF THE

INFORMATION-SHARING AND

GATHERING WE ARE DOING WHEN

WE ARE THINKING ABOUT THE

PEOPLE WE SUPPORT, RIGHT?

THINKING ABOUT THE NEED FOR

CROSSED-TRAINING AND

CROSSED-ACCESSIBILITY IS

HUGE. I AM NOT TRYING TO BE

HEROES BUT LISTENING TO

THEIR INDIVIDUAL NEEDS IS

ABSOLUTELY. NO ONE NEEDS A

HERO OR DON'T NEED RESCUING

BUT THEY JUST NEED SUPPORT.

SOMETIMES PEOPLE NEED

SOMEBODY TO LISTEN AND

CLARIFYING THAT

CONFIDENTIAL NEEDS. WE

DIDN'T CLARIFY WHAT OUR

LIMITS WERE AND WHAT WE CAN

AND CAN'T SHARE BASED ON

OUR PROFESSION. ONE OF THE

THINGS WE WANT TO HIGHLIGHT

HERE IS WE ARE TALKING

ABOUT COLLABORATION JUST,

YOU KNOW, A STRUCTURE THAT

WE HAVE SEEN THAT HAS

WORKED. FOR INSTANCE, WITH

MYSELF, I USE TO CHEER THE

NORTH CAROLINA COALITION

AGAINST A TEAM OF

TRAFFICKING. WE HAD FOUR

DIFFERENT COMMITTEES,

DIRECT SERVICE PROVIDER,

AND TRAINING EDUCATION.

REALLY, WE USE THESE AS

WORKING GROUPS AND

SUBCOMMITTEES TO TACKLE THE

KEY ISSUES THAT WE WERE

SAYING WITHIN THE

TRAFFICKING WORK.

ALSO, WHEN WE SAW IT

HAPPENING, WE NEEDED TO

MAKE DECISIONS, WE SORT OF

HAD ONE OR TWO PEOPLE WHO

WERE CHAIRS THAT WERE THE

HEAD OF THESE COMMUNITIES

THAT WE ALL GOT TOGETHER TO

MAKE QUICK DECISIONS AND

MAKING SURE THAT WE ALL

WEIGH IN ON THE MISSION AND

GOALS OF THE ORGANIZATION

AND THINKING ABOUT WHAT

PROCEDURES AND PROTOCOLS

THAT WE NEEDED TO HAVE A

COORDINATED SYSTEMATIC

RESPONSE, MAKING SURE THEY

WERE ALL WEIGHING ON IT

BECAUSE IT LOOKS DIFFERENT

DEPENDING ON WHAT THAT

AGENCY OR INSTITUTIONS WAS,

RIGHT? ONE OF THE BIGGEST

THINGS OF HAVING A

STRUCTURE IS MAKING SURE WE

HAVE ACCOUNTABILITY. IT

INCREASES SUSTAINABILITY AS

WE ALL WORK TOGETHER IN

THIS STRUCTURE. WE ARE NOT

SAYING THIS IS THE BEST

STRUCTURE, WE ARE JAMES

HURST SAYING THAT THIS IS A

STRUCTURE THAT WORKED. YOU

HAVE TO FIND WHAT WORKS FOR

YOUR COMMUNITY, RIGHT? WHAT

YOU HAVE AVAILABLE? WE

DON'T WANT YOU TO CREATE A

WHOLE NEW TASK FORCE JUST

FOR TRAFFICKING IF YOU ONLY

HAD FOUR OR FIVE CASES IN

THE LAST TWO OR THREE

YEARS. WE DO THINK THAT YOU

CAN HAVE A SUBCOMMITTEE OF

A CURRENT TASK FORCE OR

COALITION THAT YOU HAVE

THAT FOCUSES ON TRAFFICKING

AND IMPROVING RESPONSE.

IT IS ABOUT WORKING WHAT

YOU HAVE AND NOT FEELING SO

OVERWHELMED THAT YOU HAVE

TO CREATE NEW THINGS TO

CREATE MORE TIME, RIGHT?

SO, NEXT SLIDE PLEASE? SO,

WE ARE GOING TO SKIP THIS

THINKING ABOUT WHAT

REALLY THINKING ABOUT THEIR

IDENTITY, WHAT MAKES UP AS

A PERSON AND HOW DO YOU

HELP ME BUT SUPPORT ME

BECAUSE I AM ALWAYS BIG ON

WATCHING THE WORD "HELP,"

TOO BECAUSE SOMETIMES IN

THE HELPING PROFESSION, WE

CAN DO HARM WITH

UNINTENTIONAL HARM WITH OUR

HELP. REALLY THINKING ABOUT

ASSESSING AND REALLY HOW DO

WE CHANGE POLICIES AND

PROCEDURES THAT WE START TO

SEE AFFECTING THE

COMMUNITIES NEGATIVELY,

RIGHT? THEN LOOKING AT

WHATEVER INFORMATION AND

IMAGES THAT WE ARE

DISPLAYING. ONE OF THE

THINGS WE DID IN MY LAST

ROLE IS CREATED DIFFERENT

SERVICE PROVIDERS,

INDIVIDUALS WHO WORK IN

CERTAIN COMMUNITIES AND

WORKING WITH SPECIFIC

GROUPS TO INFORM MY WORK.

WHETHER IT IS OUR TRAINING,

OUTREACH OR JUST MATERIALS

THAT WE PUT OUT, WE WOULD

ALWAYS MAKE SURE THOSE

THINGS WENT TO THOSE GROUPS

SO THEY CAN LOOK AT THOSE

AND PROVIDING FEEDBACK

ABOUT HOW THAT WOULD BE

RECEIVED WITHIN THE

COMMUNITY. WHAT ARE SOME

THINGS THAT MAY NOT

UNINTENTIONALLY BUT MAY

COME ACROSS NEGATIVE OR

CONFUSING.

WE JUST MADE SURE THAT WE

TALK TO THE PEOPLE WHO WERE

WORKING IN THOSE

COMMUNITIES BECAUSE ONE

THING WE NOTICED THAT NO

MATTER HOW MANY TIMES YOU

SAY I AM A HUMAN

TRAFFICKING AGENCY OR

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AGENCY,

IF YOU HAVE A

CULTURAL-SPECIFIC AGENCY IN

YOUR COMMUNITY AND SAY THEY

WORK WITH, DEAF/BLIND/HARD

OF HEARING, IF I AM

IDENTIFIED AS HARD OF

HEARING, I AM GOING TO

CONTINUE TO GO TO THAT

CULTURAL-SPECIFIC TO HELP

WITH MY NEEDS. IT IS

IMPORTANT THAT WE ARE

LISTENING TO THEM AT THE

TABLE WHEN WE ARE DOING

THIS WORK. SO REALLY

COORDINATING AND SUPPORTING

SURVIVORS AS WELL.

ABOUT AS WE KIND OF, YOU

THINKING ABOUT WHEN YOU ARE

REACHING OUT AND WORKING

WITH SURVIVORS, YOU WANT TO

MAKE SURE YOUR AGENCY IS

PREPARED TO PROVIDE THE

SERVICES. WE HOPE THE

INFORMATION THAT YOU GOT IN

THE WEBINAR REALLY HELPS TO

BUILD SOME OF THESE OR

ENHANCE OUR CAPACITY TO

SUPPORT YOUR SURVIVORS IN

EQUITABLE AND INCLUSIVE

WAY. YOU WANT TO THINK

INTERSECTIONALTY OF

TRAFFICKING SURVIVORS

SPECIFICALLY SO THEY REALLY

UNDERSTAND THEIR NEEDS AND

IDENTIFY WHAT THOSE OPTIONS

THAT THEY MAY NEED TO HAVE

PRESENT ARE. MAKE SURE YOU

KNOW YOUR STATE AND FEDERAL

LAWS AND REGULATIONS THAT

ADDRESS HUMAN TRAFFICKING

AND THIS IS REALLY BIG WHEN

WE ARE THINKING OF WHAT

YOUR REPORTING LAWS AND

WHETHER IT IS MANDATORY

REPORTING OR LOOKING AT

PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

AND FINALLY, WHAT BENEFITS

ARE AVAILABLE AT A STATE

AND FEDERAL LEVELS FOR

SURVIVORS. THINKING OF SOME

OF THOSE RELATIONSHIPS

WITHIN YOUR

MULTI-DISCIPLINARY TEAMS

AND ALSO WITHIN YOUR AGENCY

THAT CAN HELP PROVIDE MORE

EFFECTIVE SERVICES TO THE

SURVIVORS THAT YOU SUPPORT.

COULD COACH AND WALK

ALONGSIDE THEM WITH HELPING

THEM WITH SKILLS. I THINK A

MENTOR FOR ME, THE

DIFFERENCE WHEN WE ARE

LOOKING AT WHAT WE ARE

CALLING MENTORS ARE PEOPLE

WHO MAY HAVE HAD SIMILAR

EXPERIENCES OR COULD REALLY

HELP ME GROW LIKE, FOR

PEER MENTORS. SO, OTHER

SURVIVORS REALLY FOUND A

WAY TO BE ADVOCATES IN OUR

AND HELP THEM GROW. I SEE

THAT MORE AS MENTORSHIP.

COUPLE OF REALLY GOOD

COMMENTS IN THE CHAT THAT I

ARE SO MANY WAYS THAT WE

ARE ABLE TO INCORPORATE AND

ENGAGE SURVIVORS THAT'S NOT

JUST ABOUT TELLING YOUR

STORY, ANOTHER BIG THING IS

MAKING SURE THAT WE ARE

PAYING SURVIVORS. AND NOT

JUST PAYING SURVIVORS

BECAUSE I HAVE SEEN SOME

AGENCY SAY WE ARE GOING TO

PAY WHAT THEY CALL EXPERT

SPEAKERS. \$400 TO DO A

TRAINING BUT WE'LL PAY THIS

SURVIVOR \$100.

MAKING SURE THAT YOU ARE

NOT ONLY PAYING BUT MAKING

IT EQUITABLE FOR THEM.
