The Domestic Violence Response Fund, established by a half-million-dollar donation from founding donor, The Allstate Foundation – was created in partnership with Futures Without Violence for the specific purpose of supporting U.S. based organizations that serve and support Black, Indigenous and People of Color survivors of domestic and sexual violence and those most vulnerable to violence who have been sheltering in place with abusers as a result of COVID-19.
