

## Handout 5: Using Interactivity Tools for Repurposing<sup>1</sup>

Traditional Classroom	Virtual Classroom
Participant Introductions/Mingles	<ol> <li>Chat: Present an opening question.</li> <li>Polling: Ask simple Yes/No question.</li> <li>Icons: Ask for a show of hands.</li> </ol>
Ice Breakers	Whiteboard
Peer-to-Peer Discussions	<ol> <li>Chat: Assign one question to each small group (four to five peers).</li> <li>Whiteboard: share whiteboard; use group grid or matrix.</li> </ol>
Self-Assessments	<ol> <li>Handout: Complete questions in handout.</li> <li>Then polling: Share results with group.</li> </ol>
Charting ideas on a Flipchart	Whiteboard: Unmute phone lines and chart discussion.
Role-playing or Practicing	Role play: Ask for two volunteers; unmute their phone lines.
Modeling Behavior	Host and Presenter: Present an effective interaction using a model or applying concepts. Then chat: Ask learners to give feedback.
Coaching Participants	Polling: Present sample statement (or show video); ask whether it is effective. Then chat: Ask learners for feedback.

Asking for Questions from Learners	Question and Answer Chat: Use separate chat or specific Q&A pod.
Asking Open-ended Questions	<ol> <li>Chat: Pose interesting question and ask for input.</li> <li>Polling: Offer multiple choice responses; allow learners to see results.</li> <li>Then chat: Ask for additional clarification.</li> </ol>
Asking Closed Questions	<ol> <li>Icons: Use raised hands or thumbs up to indicate agreement; thumbs down to show disagreement.</li> <li>Polling: Present closed question with Yes/No response; show results.</li> <li>Then call out: Call on participants by name to explain their response.</li> </ol>
Checking the Pulse of the Class	Icons: Ask for thumbs up or down regarding pace or content.
Presenting a Video	Video: Send prior to web session or show it in web platform.
Checking for Understanding	<ol> <li>Icons: Use raised hands or thumbs up.</li> <li>Then chat: Ask for application examples.</li> <li>Then Audio: Call on volunteers with raised hand and unmute their phone line to share an example.</li> </ol>
