### **GBV BY THE NUMBERS**

- Worldwide, 600 million women are living in countries where domestic violence is still not against the law
- Almost 750 million women
   & girls alive today were married under the age 18
- At least 200 million women & girls alive today have undergone FGM/C
- 71% of all human trafficking victims around the world are women and girls
- In 2012 I in 2 women killed worldwide were killed by their partners or family
- 82% of women parliamentarians who participated in a study conducted in 39 countries across 5 regions reported having experienced some form of psychological violence while serving their terms.
